



How to Make a Plumeria Hair Decoration



You will need a toothpick and five flowers (4 of one color and 1 different color for center flower).



Start with the center flower. Insert the toothpick horizontally through the stem.



Move the flower to the center of the toothpick.



Remove 1 petal from flower #2.



Insert toothpick into flower #2 on the side where the petal was removed.



Slide flower #2 up next to the center flower. The two flowers should be hugging each other.



Make sure flower #2 is under the center flower



Remove one petal from flower #3 and continue on the opposite side.



Do the same with flowers #4 and #5, sliding each flower under the last one. Use bobby pins to secure in hair, above the right ear (single/looking) or left ear (married/unavailable).
